"Quick Start" Registration Guide for CISN/isplay

Step 1: See if your organization is already a CISN Display user:

http://www.cisn.org/software/login/displayAllOrgs.php

Look over the registered organizations; if your group is listed, call or send an e-mail to the listed "local administrator" to obtain a "registration code". If your organization is not listed proceed to **Step 3**.

Step 2: Create a "CISN Display user account" using a "registration code":

A valid "registration code", will allow a new user to create an individual account by going to the above link. When "user account" creation is completed, proceed to **Step 4** to get the software.

Step 3: Register as a new organization by opening a Web browser to:

http://www.cisn.org/software/login/createOrg.php?yes

Provide the information requested, hit "create", you'll receive an automated message in your inbox, click the hyperlink to validate your address. Within 1-2 working days you'll receive a reply indicating approval/denial of your request. If approved, you're the new "local Administrator" for your group and will receive a default username/password. To allow others to create personal accounts within your organization, provide them with the "Registration Code" that accompanied your approval, and have them proceed with **Step 2** above.

Step 4: Log in using your newly created account... and make sure you have JAVA!

After logging in, click on "CISN Display Client Software" link. Before proceeding any further, you'll want to ensure you have the Java Runtime Environment (JRE) 1.4.X or higher installed. If you don't know where to look on your system, contact your local systems administrator for help. To download Java click on the link: http://java.com/en (It's free!). Note: installation of new software sometimes requires administrative privileges. If any part of the installation fails, contact your local systems administrator. Once you have Java setup, click "Interactive Cross-Platform Installer Programs" link and go to Step 5.

Step 5: Download and Install the CISN Display software:

On Windows machines click the "Start Installer for Windows" bar and begin download of the software and follow the instructions as outlined. Once installed, launch the program, enter your user-account username/password (created above) and check the lower-right corner for a green status light that indicates a good connection to a QuakeWatch Server. That's it; you're connected and receiving messages.

Step 6: Refer to the CISN Display User's Guide to learn more about customizing your user-interface settings... every organization should do this!
